

**INFORMATION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTION COMMISSION  
ON 13<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2004**

**On the number of people put upon the voting lists and the number of voters  
who were given the voting cards for the election to the European Parliament until 6.00  
p.m. on 13<sup>th</sup> June 2004**

**I. Collective data on the country**

The National Election Commission, on the basis of the data received from **24 876** district election commissions out of **24 918** district commissions set up throughout the country (that is without the districts set up abroad and on ships) informs that the situation on 13<sup>th</sup> June at **6.00** p.m. is as follows:

1. The number of people eligible for voting in the election, that is the number of voters put upon the voting lists in the districts from which the data were provided was **29 920 885**
2. **4 607 588** voting cards were given out to the eligible constituents, which constitutes 15.40% in relation to the number of the eligible voters.
