INFORMATION AFTER THE PRESS CONFERENCE OF THE NATIONAL ELECTION COMMISSION (PKW) HELD ON THE 13TH JUNE AT 7.30 P.M.

In the conference participated: the chairman of the National Election Commission, Judge Ferdynand Rymarz, the deputy chairman, Judge Stanisław Kosmal, members of the National Election Commission, Judges: Włodzimierz Ryms, Stanisław Zabłocki, Andrzej Kisielewicz, Andrzej Mączyński and the Secretary of the National Election Commission, Kazimierz Wojciech Czaplicki.

During the conference the chairman of PKW, judge Ferdynand Rymarz provided information concerning the number of people who took part in the election to the European Parliament till 6.00 p.m.. According to the data received from 24 876 district election commissions, 4 607 588 eligible constituents voted in the election until 6.00 p.m., which constitutes 15,4% of the eligible constituents.

The highest attendance was noted in constituency no. 4 Warsaw – where 21,44% of the eligible voted in the election. The attendance which was higher than average was also in constituency no. 1 in Gdańsk – 17,60%, no. 9 Rzeszów – 16,41%, no. 10 Cracow – 15,97%, no. 11 Katowice – 15,72%. The lowest attendance was noted in constituency no. 13 Gorzów Wielkopolski – 13,46%, no. 3 Olsztyn – 13,59% and in the constituencies no. 2 Bydgoszcz and no. 3 Wrocław – 13,98%.
